1. He who walks with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed. *Proverbs 13:20 NKJV*

2. Rejoice always! Pray without ceasing! In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit. Do not despise prophecies. But test all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from every form of evil. *1 Thessalonians 5:16-22 EMTV*

3. We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ, *2 Corinthians 10:5 ESV*

4. See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ. *Colossians 2:8 ESV*

5. If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. *Colossians 3:1-2 EMTV*

6. Nor shall you bring an abomination into your house, lest you be doomed to destruction like it. You shall utterly detest it and utterly abhor it, for it is an accursed thing. *Deuteronomy 7:26 NKJV*

7. Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. *Ephesians 6:10-11 NASB*

8. Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for what a man sows, this also he will reap. For he who sows to his flesh, from his own flesh will reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap everlasting life. *Galatians 6:7-8 EMTV*

9. Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes, and shrewd in their own sight!

10. Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

11. How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word. With my whole heart I have sought You; Oh, let me not wander from Your commandments! Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You. *Psalms 119:9-11 NKJV*

12. Teach me, O LORD, the way of Your statutes, And I shall keep it to the end. Give me understanding, and I shall keep Your law; Indeed, I shall observe it with my whole heart. Make me walk in the path of Your commandments, For I delight in it. Incline my heart to Your testimonies, And not to covetousness. Turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things, And revive me in Your way. *Psalms 119:33-37 NKJV*

13. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. *Romans 12:2 NKJV*

14. I will set nothing wicked before my eyes; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not cling to me. *Psalms 101:3 NKJV*

15. Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life." *John 8:12 NASB*
